Dear ASCS Families,

Thanks to the many of you who donated to this week's Giving Tuesday! We are blessed and humbled by your generosity, and excited for the upcoming improvements to the school. God bless you!

You probably have heard that the CDC changed the quarantine requirements for Covid this week. We have adjusted our plan to follow the CDC Guidelines, but we also will work together for each individual situation. Here is the new plan for ASCS:

Any staff/student quarantined and tested, resulting in a negative test, will now quarantine for 7 days. Any staff/student quarantined but not tested, will be required to quarantine for 10 days. The CDC further stated that 14 days is still best, and so parents will make the decision for their child to quarantine for the full 14 days. Quarantine means staying at home and out of contact with anyone outside of your immediate household.

Note: Guidelines listed above are specifically for quarantined staff/students who have not developed and/or exhibited any Covid symptoms during the time period.

Option C is used for many purposes here at ASCS. If your family has any personal changes in information such as address, phone number, email, work phone, etc., you should go into your account and update those changes. We also are able to do that for you, if you let us know. It is critical for your child's safety to keep us informed of these changes – especially phone numbers. Thank you.

Registration for the 2021-2022 school year opens Monday, January 4, 2021 for Preschool – Grade 8 students. We have purchased yard signs to help promote and advertise our fabulous school, and would LOVE for you to take a sign! We are asking for a \$4 donation to help offset the cost of the signs. Please let us know if you would be willing to help spread the good news about ASCS and Preschool. We will also have signs available on the outside table near the school main entrance. Thank you!

I have been giving many students “friendly” reminders about following the dress code. We are seeing many students in gym pants that are not dress code, non-uniform sweatshirts in the classroom, socks that do not cover the ankles, jewelry (other than a simple cross and chain) and nail polish. Students who continue to violate the dress code will receive a written warning which will be sent home for parent signature. Thank you for your help in getting all students back on track and unified!
